We encourage the Government of Switzerland to disclose the number of days done by soldiers and to reduce accordingly the number of days imposed on persons doing the alternative service

Access to civil service

We encourage the Swiss Government to include civilians at the recruitment and to adopt lighter admission criteria for those demanding the civil service

Call for military duty;
Access to a proper remedy

We ask for a judicial or independent control over the calls for these periods of service

Other recommendations

- To establish independent mechanisms for the prevention and control of use of force
- To adopt exemplary measures to regulate business and human rights
- To present its plan to reach 0.7% of GDP for development
- To explore new ways to enhance the participation of youth in the decision-making process
- To open up a peace fund where tax payers can pay their taxes, instead of paying them for the military budget
- And as a champion of "direct democracy", to forward the concept and it advantages, worldwide, whenever possible
